

From The Pastor.

The New England Puritans criminalized Christmas in 1659, when the General Court of Massachusetts passed the Five-Shilling Anti-Christmas Law: Whosoever shall be found observing any such day as Christmas, or the like, either by forbearing labor, feasting, or any other way upon such account as aforesaid, every such person so offending shall pay for each offense five shillings as a fine to the country.

The Five-Shilling Law was repealed in 1681. Perhaps they finally decided that outlawing Christmas was like outlawing love. But even after the American Revolution, the day was not declared an official holiday, given the fact that Congress was in session on Christmas Day, 1789, the first Christmas under America's new Constitution. Christmas did not become a federal holiday until 1870!

If the original Puritans could see a mob of people whipped into a frenzy by some department store offering a few items on sale at 3:00 AM on a Friday morning, they may stand back and say, "See…I told you so!" But such is life in 21<sup>st</sup> century America. And such is the overbooked, hectic, harried, frenetic lifestyle many believe to be inevitable during this season.

Thank God for the church—and not just this church, but all churches—that slow us down and call a halt to the frenzy long enough to pause before a manger and listen to the heartbeat of the universe. And they don't even charge five shillings!




## From the Board of Missions
