Sexton's Helpers' Initiative

At an Adult Forum talk in early May, Stan Lemons mentioned that the Meeting House is the largest 18th century wooden building left standing in the United States today. With that uniqueness, comes the responsibility to see that this beloved building is kept in the best condition possible. Many of you have noted the Exterior Maintenance that has been going in the past couple of weeks, including power washing the building and replacing rotten wood and the like. Obviously, the inside of the building also needs care and while we have a full-time sexton, who does an admirable job, he cannot be all places at once.
