- ♥ **Summer Worship at 10:00 AM will continue through September 6th.**

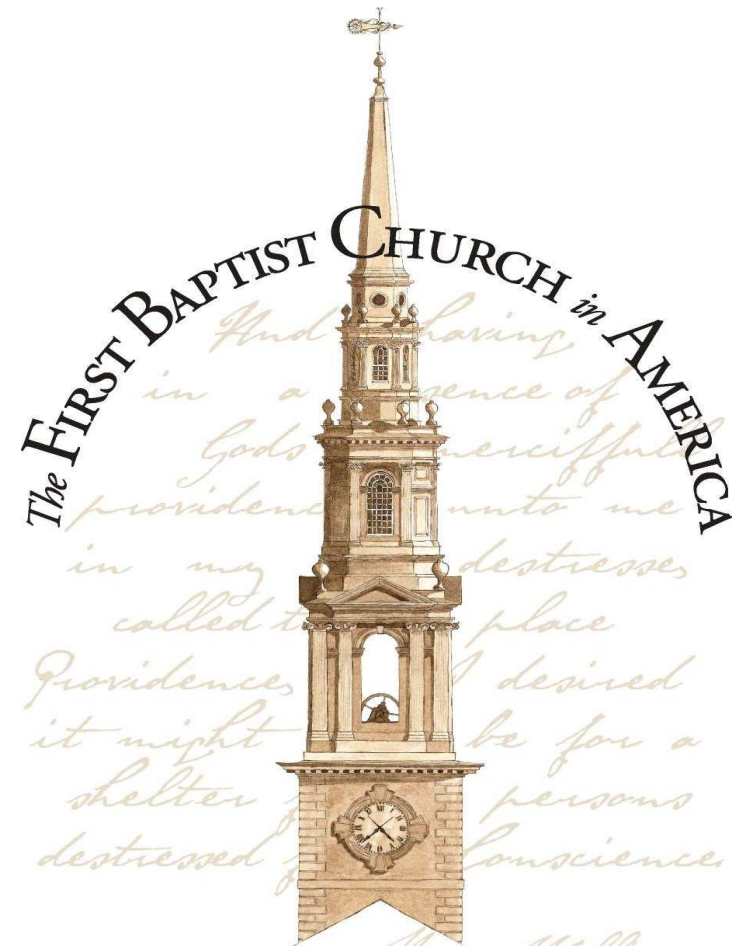
